- * Sent your ward along with hand sanitizer & proper clean water bottle daily. If the zip of bag is broken kindly repair it or change it.
- * Hair of your ward should be neat & clean. Girl child will use proper hair bands or clip on hair (if hair is small) or make 2 plates of hair.
- * Fees have to be deposited by the 10 of every month. If your ward two month feeds balance, he/she will not permitted administrator / Principal with written application.
- * Please intimate the school office in case of any change in the address, mobile no., aadhar no. * emergency contact number to keep the school database updated.
- * All leave application should be apply online only Government hospital medical will be accepted for examination.
